Requiring a sympathetic approach to existing historical structures and significant engineering challenges, Hardy Milazzo won the rights to design The Prince Alfred College Senior School Sports Centre; a significant structure housing a broad range of sporting codes for student and public use, the new centre.

**PEOPLE** With many of their boys achieving very high status within the state and national sporting codes, the new centre aims to instil pride in the school's sporting heritage; fostering a sense of community and belonging, while inspiring a sense of drive and ambition to achieve at a personal level.

**PLACE** The existing sports centre was the site for the development, and the new Centre interprets and substantially extends these facilities. The total development re-defines the north-western corner of the grounds with a bold statement to the parade West frontage.

**PURPOSE** The new centre caters for a broad range of sporting codes, including indoor court sports, swimming, squash, weight-training, rowing, aerobics and dancing, whilst also providing classroom space for Physical Education theory. Regional-sized courts also enable the halls to be hired for public use if the school deems it appropriate.
